Thank you for your email of 8 March 2018 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information:

"How many primary/secondary state schools sit on leased land?"

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

As at 23 April 2017 our records indicate that of approximately 2,100 state schools, 179 are currently operating on leased sites. This includes schools located on partially leased sites. Please note this includes intermediate, composite, and area schools, but does not include special schools, teen parent units, activity centres, or proposed schools.
