Strengthening Digital Technologies | Hangarau Matihiko in the curriculum

The Ministry of Education now invites submissions on the draft Digital Technologies | Hangarau Matihiko (DT | HM) curriculum.

To equip our learners for the increasingly digitalised workplace and society, the Ministry of Education is strengthening *The New Zealand Curriculum* and *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa* – the two documents which comprise our National Curriculum for schools and kura.

Our education system needs to change how we prepare our children and young people to participate, create and thrive in this fast-evolving digital world.

Consultation process

The consultation process will run until 3 September. We are particularly keen to hear from the education and technology sectors as well as parents, students and their whānau.

We welcome your feedback and all submissions will be considered with a report back later in 2017.

Timeframe to integrate the new curriculum content

From the first term of 2018, DT | HM will be included in the New Zealand Curriculum and Te Marautanga o Aotearoa. The new curriculum content will be mandatory for use in all state and state-integrated schools from 2020.
