Thank you for your emails of 13 and 28 January 2021 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information.

Request one: (13 January 2021)

- *How Many Pupils have left Waimea College to Move to other Schools from April 2016 till January 13th, 2021?*
- *How many Pupils have left Nelson College to move to other Schools from April 2016 till January 13th 2021?*
- *How many Pupils have left Garin College to move to other Schools from April 2016 to January 2021?*
- *How Many pupils have left Nelson College for Girls to move to other Schools from April 2016 to 13th January 2021? (our ref: METIS 1248492)*

Request two: (28 January 2021)

- *"...the numbers of Pupils that have left Nayland College to move /re-enrol in other Schools from April 2016 till January 2021 (our ref: METIS 1249396)"*

Your requests have been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Request one

The total number of students who left *Waimea College* to move to other schools between April 2016 and January 13, 2021 is 339.

The total number of students who left *Nelson College* to move to other schools between April 2016 and January 13, 2021 is 311.

The total number of students who left *Garin College* to move to other schools from April 2016 and January 13, 2021 is 122.

Total number of students who left Nelson College for girls to move to other schools between April 2016 and January 13, 2021 is 393.

Request two

The total number of students who left *Nayland College* to move to other schools between April 2016 and January 2021 is 344.

Please note the following caveats that apply to this information:

- Data provided is based on all students enrolled at Garin College, Nelson College, Nayland College, Nelson College for Girls and Waimea College between 1 April 2016 and 13 January 2021.
- We have only counted students who had a record of another enrolment at another school after leaving one of the schools included.
- Data is extracted as at 3 February 2021. This data is subject to change and may differ if re-run at a later date. The Ministry cannot guarantee the accuracy of the information as we are reliant on schools recording the information into the ENROL system.

Please note, the Ministry now proactively publishes responses under the Act on our website. As such, we may publish this response on our website after five working days. Your name and contact details will be removed.
